

### CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

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#### Regular Cleaning:

- For everyday cleaning, wipe the surface with a damp cloth or sponge. You may use a mild soap or detergent. Wipe completely dry with a soft rag using a straight-line motion.

### SPECIAL CARE TIPS

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- Keep your furniture out of direct sunlight. Prolonged exposure may cause the color to fade over time.
- Hot pans or heat producing appliances, when set directly on the painted surface, can mar the product's surface. Always use a heat shield, hot pad, or trivet.
- Sharp knives can damage the painted surface lowering the wear and exposing the raw metal surface. Always use a cutting board if cutting directly on the surface.
- Acidic or abrasive cleaners can damage painted surfaces; do not use them to clean the surface. ***Avoid products that contain any of the following:***
  - Hydrochloric Acid
    - Muriatic Acid
    - Hydrogen Chloride
  - Sulfuric Acid
    - Oleic Acid
    - Oil of Vitriol
    - Oleum
  - Hydrofluoric Acid
    - Rust Remover
  - Phosphoric Acid
    - Rust remover
  - Sodium Hydroxide
    - Caustic Soda
    - Caustic
    - Lye
    - Soda Lye
  - Pumice (Abrasive)

- If you spill a product containing one of these chemicals on the surface, wipe up immediately, wash with soapy water, and rinse several times.
